If local governing boards are to hold their schools effectively to account for pupils' achievement, they need to ask meaningful questions about pupil attainment and progress data. The aim of the session is to promote governors' understanding and practical use of external school data.

This is a course about school improvement, not statistics, and the approach is a pragmatic look at the questions raised by our schools' main external data sources, helping governors from our primary schools to understand the terminology, identify the areas for improvement in their schools and relate data to real school performance.
